

Launch of ClinTrial Refer Version 2

The biggest highlight of 2019 was the launch and release of ClinTrial Refer Version 2. Our sincere thanks to The Hon Greg Hunt MP, Minister for Health, who supported the launch in October at the ACTA International Clinical Trials conference in Sydney. ClinTrial Refer Version 2 integrates new features and upgrades for users to make finding the right trial easier, and also system improvements to make the updating of trial information easier for App Managers.

ClinTrial Refer won the inaugural Health Roundtable Shark Tank Innovation Pitch award in 2019. The Health Roundtable is a non-profit membership organisation of public and private health services and hospitals across Australia and New Zealand representing over 200 health facilities. This award has provided ClinTrial Refer with invaluable support, expert guidance and mentorship from Health Roundtable team members. ClinTrial Refer was also honoured to be a finalist in the global Clinical & Research Excellence Awards (CARE) for the Best Patient Focussed Technological Development in 2019.

Presentations

Another key highlight in 2019 for ClinTrial Refer was the beginning of our work with the primary care community to explore an improved role for general practitioners in clinical trial recruitment and referral. ClinTrial Refer partnered with the Australian Healthcare and Hospitals Association and the Deeble Institute for Health Policy Research to host the primary care roundtable discussion. This pivotal event provided a platform for participants to share experiences, knowledge and reflections on issues related to clinical trial recruitment. Attendees included researchers, general practitioners, Primary Health Network leaders and consumers. A follow up event is planned for 2020.

ClinTrial Refer was also invited to present and showcase the app at several medical and clinical trial conferences throughout the year. These forums provided a wonderful opportunity to raise awareness of ClinTrial Refer as an innovative resource providing easy access to current clinical trials and also to build the ClinTrial Refer community of users.
